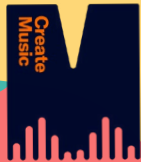

If you're aged 10-15 and Grade 3+ on your orchestral instrument, come and join us at our free LPO Junior Artists: Overture day at Ratton School on Wednesday 16 April. This Overture day is delivered in partnership with Create Music, the hub lead organisation for the Sussex Music hub.

LPO Junior Artists: Overture days are fun orchestral skills days, where participants play alongside LPO musicians, get tips on musicianship, and find out what happens behind the scenes of a professional orchestra.

In this Overture day we will play music that will take us to magical, mythical lands, including extracts from Tchaikovsky's *The Nutcracker*, Grieg's 'In the Hall of the Mountain King,' and music from Dreamworks Animation's *How to Train Your Dragon*.

Applications are open to all but priority is given to young musicians whose backgrounds are currently underrepresented in professional UK orchestras, who may be eligible for the main LPO Junior Artists programme in the future.
